



## Phase 2:

### Safety Measures Requested for a Smooth Reopening for Studio Central

**Updated Hours:** Tuesday-Friday 12:30-4:30pm  
**(12 guests max at a time)**

#### **General Safety Measures**

- Please give your neighbours a minimum 2m/6.5ft social distancing space.
- We request that you please wear a face mask in our space to help stop the spread of any virus.  
*\*Access to disposable face masks for participants and staff to wear during time in studio are available at the reception desk.*
- Hand sanitizer and Lysol wipes are available at reception desk and café counter.
- One participant per table in art space or café\*  
*\*exception to those who share a household - extra chairs are provided*
- Please be mindful of yourself and others. Cover all coughs and sneezes with your elbow, and wash your hands frequently for a 20 second minimum.

**Café Central** is to remain closed for the time being.

- Cold drinks (water, juice, iced tea) will be available but must be served by staff or trained volunteer while wearing gloves and using disposable cups. Refills must be in new cup.

#### **Art Supplies Protocol**

- Art supplies will be distributed by staff or trained volunteer (drawing supplies, brushes, wet paint, markers, etc.). Participants are asked to wipe down their space and materials after use. At the end of the workshop, participants can put clean materials in basket for FULL disinfecting.
  - *All reusable supplies must be sanitized after each use.*
  - *Certain materials will be unusable if not able to sanitize properly (i.e. oil pastels/chalk, conte).*
- We encourage you to bring your own supplies if you're able.
- Drawing horses are available for use – please make sure to give those around you a minimum of 6ft space

#### **Masks Statement:**

Public health experts recommend the use of masks or face coverings in public settings. To protect our community, it is recommended to wear a mask or face covering that covers the mouth and nose while in our space. This recommendation does not apply to individuals who are unable to wear a mask or face covering due to a medical condition. The use of a mask or face covering should not be seen as a substitute for social distancing. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
