She also, volunteers at Studio Central (community outreach), teaching workshops. Kathleen is inspired by life, love, nature, music and spirituality. She enjoys inspiring others to live to their full potential and follow their dreams. She is currently working at her exchange district studio and she sells her works privately and out of Pulse Gallery in the Johnston terminal and Art gallery of South Western Manitoba, in Brandon.
